BBB's Excellence Awards Honor Galsons, Abrahams

HOUSTON: The luncheon last Wednesday, May 2 at the Intercontinental Hotel on the West Loop had a record turnout of 900 people as the Better Business Bureau gave out its coveted 20th Annual Awards for Excellence to area businesses which are members of the organization.
